Sales Continue to Soar Through July

Vancouver, BC. British Columbians contributed to the nation-wide growth of residential mortgage loans in July 2002 as buyers took advantage of low mortgage rates and an improving provincial economy. The Multiple Listing Service® reported the sale of 6,973 homes – a nearly eight per cent increase from the same period last year.

website www.bcrea.bc.ca "Conditions in BC mean that even traditionally slower months for housing sales, such as July, have produced record-breaking figures for the industry," says British Columbia Real Estate Association President Dennis Wilson. "It's yet another sign of the strength of the real estate recovery in BC."

Other signs of the resurgence in the BC real estate market include a 27.7 per cent increase in urban BC housing starts in July and a 15 per cent jump in building permits in June as reported by BC Stats and Statistics Canada, respectively.

"All twelve real estate boards in BC reported increases in residential home sales over July 2001. Seven boards saw increases of 10 per cent or more," says Wilson. "We expect these kinds of figures to continue throughout 2002."
